

# MAQUET CRITICAL CARE RECEIVES 510(k) CLEARANCE FOR ITS FLOW-i ANESTHESIA DELIVERY SYSTEM

**Solna, Sweden, June 14, 2011**—MAQUET Critical Care AB today announced it has received 510(k) clearance from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for its MAQUET FLOW-i anesthesia system, including the C20, C30 and C40 models. FLOW-i is a high performance system designed to meet ventilatory challenges within anesthesia, as well as to provide inhalation anesthesia in a broad range of patients, from neonatal to adult.

The system is intended for use in administrating anesthesia while controlling the entire ventilation in patients with no ability or limited ability to breathe. MAQUET Critical Care's FLOW-i anesthesia delivery system combines advanced ICU SERVO ventilator performance with state-of-the-art anesthesia delivery.
